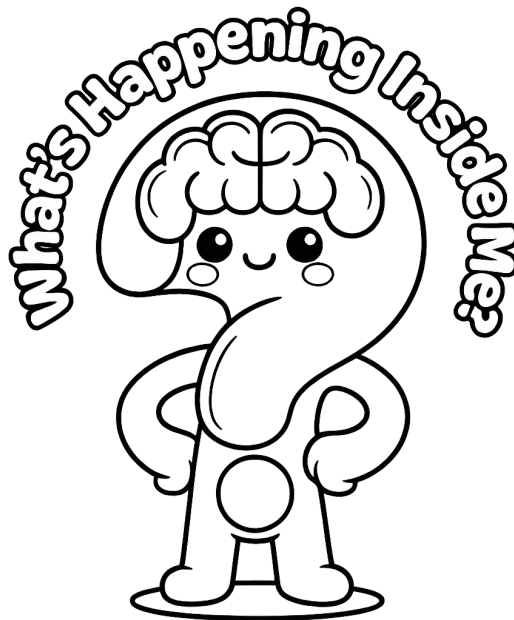

5. ENJOY!!

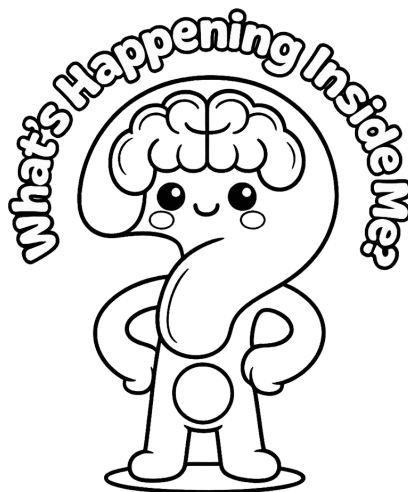
