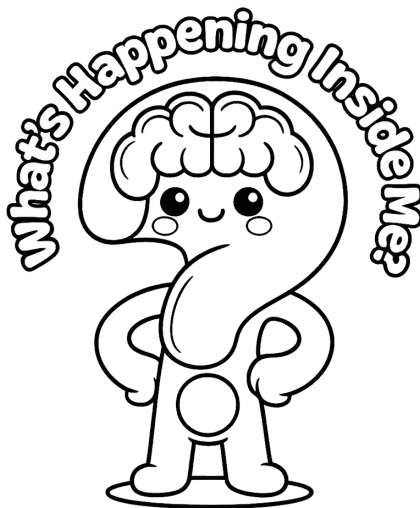
1. the big air tube that connects the mouth/nose to the lungs

5. swelling of the bronchi, usually from a virus



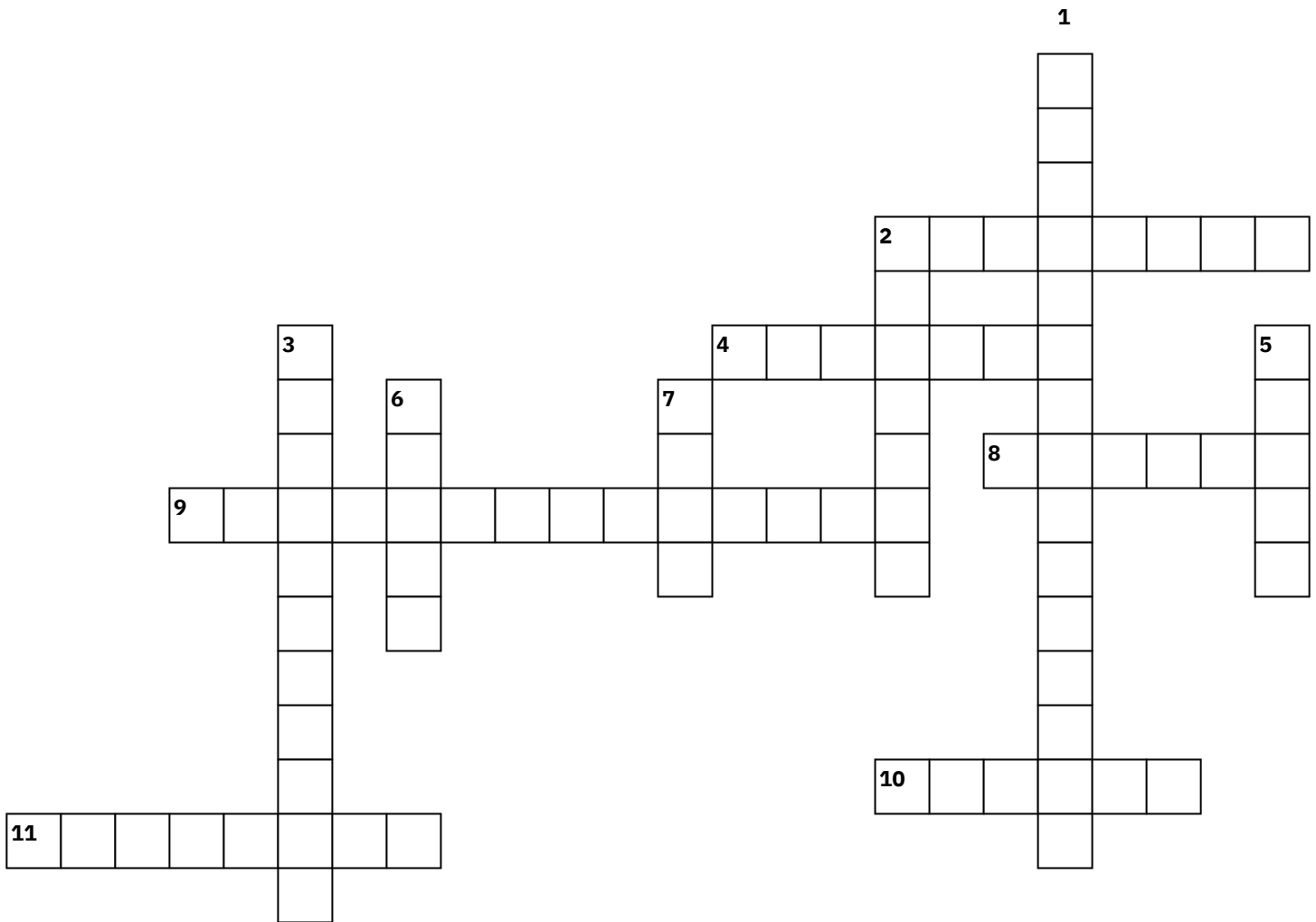

Episode 6: Accessory Organs

- 2. hormone that tells the liver to make sugar
- 4. hormone that helps sugar get into cells to make energy
- 8. accessory organ that moves food around mouth and to throat for swallowing
- 9. accessory organs that make saliva (spit)
- 10. medical word for spit
- 11. accessory organ that helps with blood sugar; makes insulin, amylase, protease and lipase

Down

- 1. "making new sugar"; liver does this when we aren't eating but need sugar/energy
- 2. sugar in the blood used for energy
- 3. accessory organ that stores and squirts bile
- 5. accessory organ that chews food (first step of digestion!)
- 6. accessory organ that makes bile and removes toxins
- 7. digestive juice from the liver; stored in the gallbladder
